

C.V. Sergej Tcherepanov

Sergej Tcherepanov was born in Kasachstan (Sowiet Union) 1967. Studied musics in Moscow at the Tchaikowsky-Conservatorium. Among his teachers were Prof. Victor Merzhanow (Piano) and Natalia Gureewa (Organ). He took part in masterclasses for Organ and Harpsichord, performed ancient music with Alexei Lubimow and baroque-ensembles, worked for Organperformance with Alexander Fiseisky. In 1996, he followed organstudies at the Music Academy in Lübeck with Prof. Martin Haselböck and in Hamburg 2000-2002 with Prof. Wolfgang Zerer. Focussing on the performance of Baroque Music on historical keyboard instruments, he took part in masterclasses with Andrea Marcon, Harald Vogel and Martin Böcker (Stade, Germany). Prizes: "Possehl-Prize" in Lübeck 1997, special Prize in Pretoria 1998, "Fugato"- Prize (Bad Homburg, Germany) 1999, Prize from "Arp-Schnitger-Gesellschaft" 2000. S.T. was Organist on the Arp-Schnitger-Organ in Steinkirchen (Altes Land, Germany), now teaching Organ at the Lübeck Music Academy.
